WHAT IS TECHSETS?

TechSETS is a collection of free and low-cost online technical support resources. TechSETS provides training, tools and information to assist the growing number of school professionals who are responsible for planning, building, maintaining, and using technology systems in education. The target audience for TechSETS includes site and district technical support staff, as well as administrators, school support staff, and teachers.

The increased use of instructional and administrative technology in California schools has created an expanded need for technical support. **TechSETS** is designed to be your “always on” tech support center, offering resources that include:

 TRAINING	Skills Matrix	TechSETS has developed a comprehensive matrix of skills needed to support technology services in California schools. In the Skills Matrix , services are arranged by category and then broken into the related tasks and skills needed to support the service.
	TechPROFILES	TechPROFILES provides a picture of what the worker does in terms of duties, tasks, knowledge, skills, and traits, as well as the tools the worker uses. Available Profiles include: School Computer Technician, School Network Technician, School Technology Director/Manager, and School Web Developer.
	My SkillSource	TechSETS has partnered with My SkillSource to offer online productivity and technical training (self-paced tutorials, instructor-led classes, virtual labs, and online reference manuals) to California school technologists at steeply-discounted prices. Training resources range from popular desktop applications to specialized technical courses on server and network management. My SkillSource offers Online Certification Exams powered by Brainbench, the leading online skills testing and certification authority.
 SUPPORT	TechQUESTIONS	TechQUESTIONS is an online help desk (discussion forum) that supports school professionals by providing answers to technical questions. This resource allows members to search through archived resolutions or to post new questions. Answers are provided by a community of technical professionals from across the state. TechQUESTIONS is used by IT staff, classroom teachers, administrators, support staff, and student tech support programs throughout the state.
	K-12 Voucher Resources	TechSETS is a partner in providing support for the Ed Tech K-12 Voucher Program . The K-12 Voucher Resources section provides links to the latest information from the California Department of Education, as well as checklists, guides, handouts, presentations, and expense-tracking tools, developed by TechSETS to assist with program planning and implementation.
	StudentTECH	TechSETS' new StudentTECH section was created to support the increasing number of schools that are implementing student tech support programs for training students in basic tech support skills. The StudentTECH resources include suggestions for establishing a student tech support program, descriptions of model programs, sample curriculum materials and activities, and sample student projects.
 TOOLS	MyTechDesk	MyTechDesk is a free workorder management system, for district and site technicians to track and manage technical support requests. End-users report problems online. Technicians assign tasks, track responses, and monitor problem resolution for everyone in the system. Using a tracking system helps maximize resources by allowing you to document the volume of services required, spot problem areas early, "right-size" your support staff based on need, and target your training efforts. All K-12 schools and districts in California, regardless of size, have access to MyTechDesk at no cost.
	TechRESOURCES	TechRESOURCES are intended to comprise a "best-of-the-best" collection of public and commercial web sites that provide documentation, support, tools, and other useful information to assist those responsible for making the technology work in schools. Web sites are nominated by the community of TechSETS members.
	TechJOBS	TechJOBS is a set of tools designed to help find or recruit technical staff. This section includes two related resources, the Job Description Builder (creates a custom job description based on the TechSETS Skills Matrix) and the Job Description Bank (a collection of job descriptions from school districts across the state).
 PARTNERS	Partners	The Partners section provides links and descriptions for our partner Statewide Education Technology Services projects (CLRN, TICAL, and EdTechProfile), as well as connections to additional organizations that are collaborating with TechSETS to provide support to California school professionals.
 MEMBERS	MyTechSETS	MyTechSETS is a personal, customizable portal for technical staff and other TechSETS members, which pulls together several useful tools for providing mobile technology support. Tools include: 2 MB online storage space, list of frequently-used bookmarks/URLs, directory of contact information, and shortcuts to favorite TechSETS resources.
	eNewsletter	TechSETS now publishes a quarterly eNewsletter to advise members of new tools and resources that have been added to the TechSETS web site, as well as to update members on technology news, upcoming trainings, and activities of interest to TechSETS members.
	RSS Feed	The TechSETS web site now includes two options for members to receive automatic notifications of TechSETS-related news and 'Expanded Technology News', via Really Simple Syndication (RSS) . Just click on the RSS link in the lower right corner of the TechSETS home page to subscribe.
